In early 2001, the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation sent you a booklet which included the 2000 Hazardous Waste Report Forms and Instructions. All large quantity generators (LQGs), in addition to RCRA treatment, storage and disposal facilities (TSDFs) must file an annual report of their hazardous waste activities for the previous calendar year by March 1 of each year, pursuant to 6 NYCRR Parts 373-1.6(a)(12)(ix) and 372.2(c)(2).

The Department has still not received the Report as of the date of this notification. The Department believes that your facility is responsible for filing a 2000 Hazardous Waste Report. This report is required by law. Failure to file can result in enforcement action, including fines of up to \$25,000 plus an additional penalty of not more than \$25,000 for each day the violation continues.

Your completed Report must be submitted within 15 business days to:
