

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC AVAILABILITY**

**THE UNITED STATES ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS  
ANNOUNCES THE AVAILABILITY OF AN  
ADMINISTRATIVE RECORD FOR A REMOVAL ACTION  
AT THE FORMER LAKE ONTARIO ORDNANCE WORKS SITE,  
LEWISTON/PORTER, NEW YORK**

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) announces the availability for public review the removal action decision document in the administrative record for the Former Lake Ontario Ordnance Works (LOOW) site located in Lewiston/Porter, Niagara County, New York. The removal action document addresses several areas of identified contamination associated with the original LOOW TNT manufacturing plant and a high energy rocket fuels pilot production plant referred to as Air Force Plant 68. Contaminated areas include surface sediments, subsurface soils, waste sewer system sludges, and local groundwater. The types of contaminants present include asbestos-containing materials, organics, heavy metals and explosives compounds. The remediation will include excavation and landfill disposal of contaminated soil, surface sediments, and asbestos-containing materials; bioremediation of explosives contaminated sediments; off-site incineration of organics contaminated sewer system sludges; and on-site treatment of groundwater.
