

Luckey Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program Site News from the Corps

Hello from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Buffalo District:

The summer dry spell that helped us advance the remediation at the Luckey Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP) Site has ended, and the fall rains have returned in force. As a result, we will begin shipping water from the site excavations off-site for disposal starting tomorrow. This will help alleviate the accumulation of water in the excavations due to the excessive amount of rain the site has been receiving recently.

When we first encountered similar conditions in June of this year, we made changes to the water management plan to accommodate the on-site loading of tanker trucks, transport to the off-site discharge location, and discharge to the approved sanitary sewer point. The sanitary sewer lines are maintained by the Northwestern Water and Sewer District and ultimately lead to the City of Toledo's publicly owned treatment works. Only water that meets the guidelines of the City of Toledo's publically owned treatment works will be transported off-site for disposal. The Corps has coordinated with the sewer district and City of Toledo to secure the necessary approvals.

This is a temporary measure that is being put in place until we reduce the amount of water stored on-site to levels that can be managed by our on-site water treatment system. This change will allow us to responsibly dispose of excess water collected on the site, and prevent cleanup work from stopping because our water treatment and storage capacity has been reached.
