

Luckey Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program Site News from the Corps

Hello from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Buffalo District:

Progress continues to be made at the Luckey Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program Site. The project team for the site cleanup has safely completed working over 300,000 hours without any lost time injuries or recordable accidents.

Many of those in the Luckey community may have noticed that a portion of the production building on the site has collapsed following the storm this past weekend. The Corps has cordoned off the area surrounding that portion of the building so that it does not present a danger to those that are working on the site. Structural engineers will be visiting the site next week to determine the building's structural stability and once that evaluation is complete, a decision will be made in regard to next steps. In the meantime, the Corps is working to acquire a contract to take the building down.

Protection of human health and the environment, conducting work in a safe and efficient manner, and preventing the spread of contamination remain as the Corps' priorities at the site.
