

## **Luckey Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program Site News from the Corps**

Hello from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Buffalo District:

Please save the date for a public information/poster session regarding the Luckey Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP) Site cleanup the evening of March 28, 2017, at the American Legion Post 240, 335 Park Drive, in Luckey, Ohio. The poster session will include several poster stations that will describe the site setup, site activities, and safety precautions that will be part of the Luckey Site cleanup when it begins this spring. Several members of the Corps of Engineers Luckey Site team, as well as contractor personnel, will be on hand to answer questions and discuss the cleanup activities with you.

The Corps of Engineers is working with our remediation contractor, to develop the work plans that describe how the cleanup work will be conducted. Contractor personnel could be on the site as early as January 16, 2017, conducting background air monitoring around the perimeter of the site. They will be setting up air monitoring stations along the fence line on each side of the site, which will run for 90 days. The contractor personnel will be wearing personal protective equipment including disposable coveralls and respirators during the initial phases of conducting the background sampling, and may reduce the level of protective clothing used as they receive air monitoring results.
