

Luckey Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program Site News from the Corps

Hello from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Buffalo District:

Beginning this week the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will be removing several stockpiles from the Luckey Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program Site to be disposed of at the US Ecology (Wayne Disposal, Inc.) facility in Belleville, Michigan.

The material will be loaded into roll-off containers with liners that will be zipped closed once they are filled. The roll-off containers will then be covered with a tarp and transported by truck to the facility. The material will remain in the liners as it is disposed. It is estimated that 42 roll-off containers will be shipped containing non-hazardous soil, trees and shrubs from clearing and grubbing performed in support of the site infrastructure setup. It is anticipated that it will take seven to eight days to ship all of the clearing-material stockpiles.
