The 2020 Niagara Falls Storage Site (NFSS) Environmental Surveillance Technical Memorandum and the 2020 National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) report for NFSS are available on the project website at: <https://www.lrb.usace.army.mil/Missions/HTRW/FUSRAP/Niagara-Falls-Storage-Site/> in the Site-Wide Environmental Monitoring portion of the Reports section. The 2020 technical memorandum and the NESHAP report findings are compliant with regulatory criteria and/or consistent with the findings of prior year evaluations and demonstrate that the site is fully protective of human health and the environment and the Interim Waste Containment Structure is performing as designed.

The district conducts the environmental surveillance program at the site to support the Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program mission to protect human health and the environment. The environmental surveillance program quantifies and evaluates radiological, chemical, and water quality data from the environment at the NFSS. Results of this program are published annually in the form of a technical memorandum. The results of the NESHAP evaluation are also published annually and support the environmental surveillance program.
