Environmental media currently monitored by the Corps include:

- Groundwater for radiological parameters,
- Drainage ditch surface water and sediment for radiological and chemical parameters,
- and
- Air for radon and external gamma radiation.

Findings from the environmental surveillance data collected are presented annually in a technical memorandum that is also available on the web.

Over 30 years of data collected at the NFSS indicate that site controls are performing as designed to protect human health and the environment.
