Hello from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Buffalo District:

The public meeting regarding the feasibility study and proposed plan for the Interim Waste Containment Structure Operable Unit of the Niagara Falls Storage Site (NFSS) will be conducted at the Town of Lewiston Senior Center, 4361 Lower River Road, Youngstown, NY 14171, on Wednesday, January 13, 2016, beginning at 6:30 p.m. The proposed plan documents the Corps of Engineers' preferred alternative for the Interim Waste Containment Structure Operable Unit, which is Alternative 4, excavation, partial treatment, and off-site disposal of the entire contents of the IWCS.
