FUSRAP - TONAWANDA SITE - AVAILABILITY OF THE DRAFT FEASIBILITY STUDY/PROPOSED PLAN-ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT

The purpose of this letter is to announce the availability of the draft Feasibility Study/Proposed Plan-Environmental Impact Statement (FS/PP-EIS) for the Tonawanda Site located in Tonawanda, New York. This site is managed by the United States Department of Energy (DOE) under the Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP) for cleanup of the radioactively contaminated soils at the four Tonawanda site properties: Ashland 1, Ashland 2, Seaway Landfill, and Linde.

Copies of the documents have been transmitted to all county, state, and Federal agencies involved with the site. Copies of the documents for your review have been placed in the DOE Administrative Record at the DOE Public Information Center, 810 Sheridan Drive and the Tonawanda Public Library, 333 Main Street in Tonawanda. Additional review copies are available at the DOE Information Repositories located at the Kenmore Public Library, 160 Delaware Avenue, Kenmore; the Parkside Village Public Library, 169 Sheridan-Parkside Drive, Town of Tonawanda; and the Grand Island Memorial Public Library, 1715 Bedell Road, Grand Island. A public meeting will be held on December 1, 1993, 7:30 p.m. at the Kenmore East Senior High School, 350 Fries Road, Tonawanda. The purpose of the meeting is to take comments from public officials and citizens on the proposed alternative for the cleanup of the Tonawanda site. Members of the community may speak at the public meeting or submit written comments to the DOE site manager anytime during the 60-day public comment period commencing on November 5, 1993.
