

Contamination ^{500 HP} sampling to begin

TONAWANDA — The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will begin sampling at the Seaway Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program Site on Monday. Sampling is being conducted to learn about the contamination in the landfill left over from the U.S. early atomic energy program.

The Seaway site, located along River Road in Tonawanda, was contaminated during the transfer of soil containing radioactive residue from the Manhattan Project.
