Hello from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Buffalo District:

The construction completion report for the soil remediation at the Landfill Operable Unit of the Tonawanda Landfill Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program Vicinity Property is available on the project website at:

Implementation of the selected remedy for the vicinity property was performed from June through December 2019. During the targeted shallow removal, 4,345 cubic yards of radioactive-contaminated soils were removed from the Landfill Operable Unit to a depth of five feet. Data gathered during the July 2020 radon flux sampling, verified that the record of decision cleanup goals have been met.

The Buffalo District is preparing a site closeout report for the vicinity property. Once the closeout report is complete, the Corps of Engineers will begin the process of transferring administrative controls and file records management responsibilities for the vicinity property to the U.S. Department of Energy Office of Legacy Management for long-term stewardship.
