

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is excited to announce that we have begun removing FUSRAP-contaminated material from the Landfill Operable Unit of the Tonawanda Landfill Vicinity Property, and disposing of it off-site at a licensed/permitted disposal facility in Belleville Michigan. Groundbreaking activities commenced on June 12, 2019 and the first of the intermodal containers left the site on June 18, 2019.

The excavated FUSRAP-contaminated material is being placed in intermodal containers which are then sealed, and prepared for pickup by the transportation and disposal contractor for transport to the rail yard in Blasdell, New York. From there the intermodal containers will be loaded onto a train and transported to a properly permitted/licensed disposal facility in Michigan.

The Corps of Engineers is committed to keeping you informed during the cleanup of Tonawanda Landfill Vicinity Property.
