Hello from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Buffalo District:

We are making progress in our cleanup at the Tonawanda Landfill Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP) Vicinity Property. To date we have excavated 3,595 tons of FUSRAP-contaminated soil from the vicinity property. We are preparing to backfill four of our eight excavation areas.

Work is going to be performed on Saturdays at the site for a while. You may hear typical construction site sounds on Saturdays between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.

Our priorities for this project are to be protective of human health and the environment, to ensure that work is conducted in a safe and efficient manner, and to prevent the spread of contamination.
