

## **Tonawanda Landfill Vicinity Property News from the Corps**

Hello from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Buffalo District:

We're making good progress in removing FUSRAP-contaminated material from the Landfill Operable Unit of the Tonawanda Landfill Vicinity Property!

We previously informed you that work would take place during the hours of 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday. Due to the excessive amounts of water in the excavation areas, our contractor will periodically need to run pumps at the site for a few hours after 4 p.m. The pumps that are being used are not expected to be overly noisy. The water is filtered before being discharged to the water treatment plant.

Residents in the vicinity of the landfill will still hear normal construction-type sounds during the cleanup between the hours of 7 a.m. and 4 p.m. Monday through Friday.
