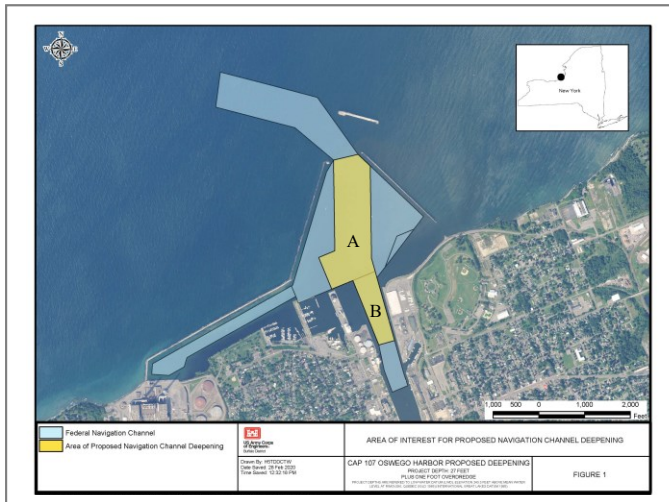

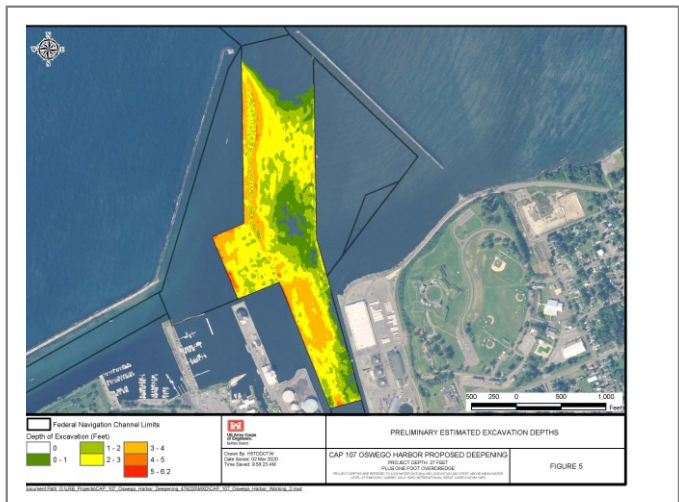
PROJECT SPONSOR:

PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND BACKGROUND:

- Section 107 provides for improvements to navigation, including dredging of channels, widening of turning basins, and construction of navigation aids.
- Potential navigation improvements include deepening the harbor to seaway depths of 27 feet.
- Design and Implementation cost sharing is based on whether project features are commercial or recreational.
