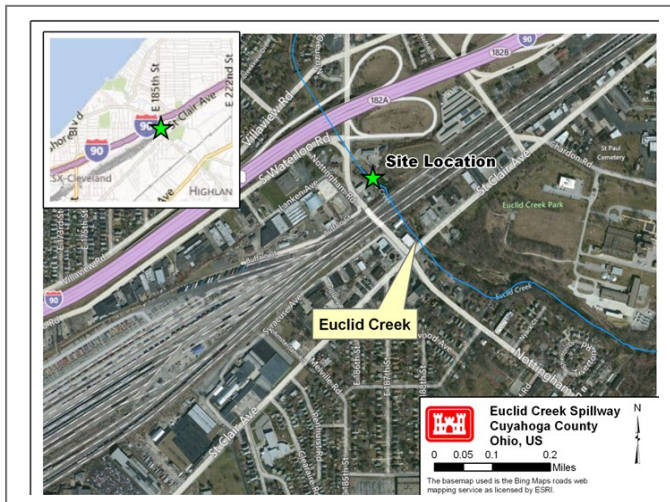


Figure 1: Map showing project location.

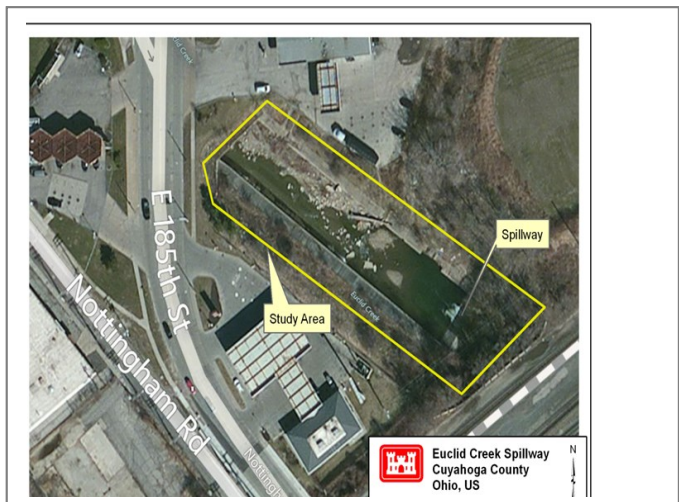


Figure 2: parameters of project within project location.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND BACKGROUND:**

- Habitat restoration of the Euclid Creek Spillway was identified in the Euclid Creek Watershed Action Plan endorsed by the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) in 2006. Restoration measures for this project could include hydrological stabilization, in-stream and streambank habitat, and riparian corridor restoration which would result in diverse fish migration, fish spawning, rearing and refuge habitats for species including Smallmouth Bass, Largemouth Bass, Central Stoneroller, and Emerald Shiner.
