## PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND BACKGROUND:

The program provides assistance and guidance in the form of "Special Studies" on all aspects of floodplain management planning including potential impacts of off-flood plain land use changes on the physical, socio-economic, and environmental conditions of the floodplain. This can range from helping a community identify present or future floodplain areas and related problems, to a broad assessment of which of the various remedial measures may be effectively used.

The Buffalo District (LRB) manages the program in close coordination with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), New York State Department of Environmental
