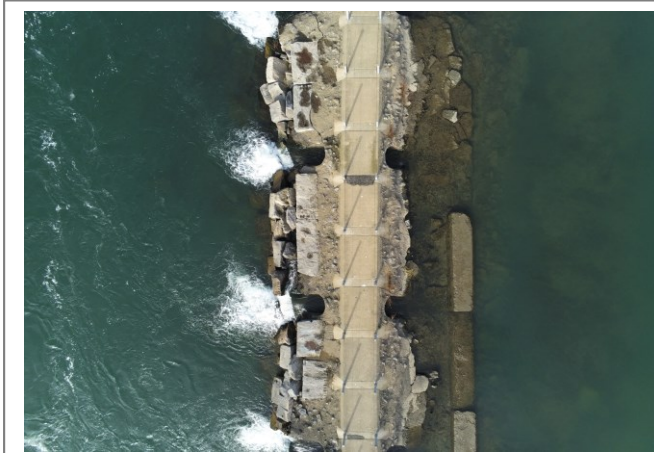


Figure 1: Aerial view of some of the damaged areas of the pier.

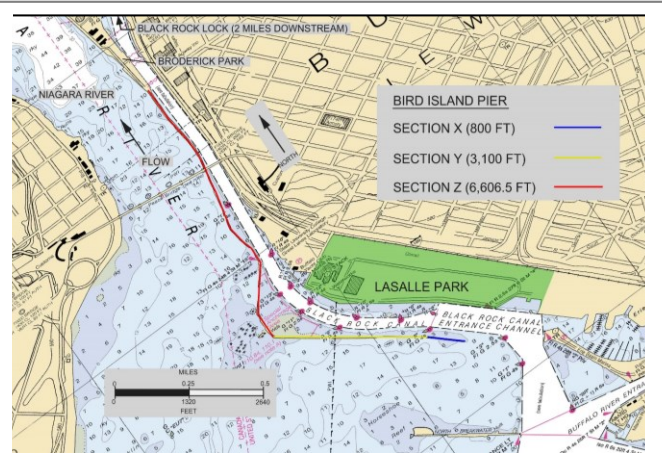


Figure 2: Overview map of Bird Island Pier and surrounding
