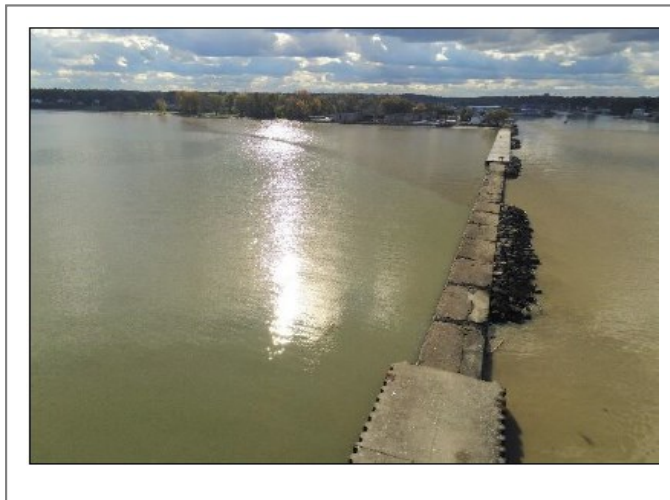

- The middle section requires new steel sheet pile walls and a new concrete cap at a length of about 1,022 feet
- The east pier allows for safe navigation between the Genesee River and Lake Ontario
