SPECIAL STUDIES — NEW YORK AND OHIO

Section 206 of the 1960 Flood Control Act, As Amended
General Investigations

Location

- Streams and rivers within the Buffalo District boundaries.

Project Description

- A special study will provide detailed hydrologic and hydraulic analyses for portions of identified creeks and streams.
- The studies will determine the 1 percent and .2 percent chance of exceedance (100- and 500-year flood plain).

Importance

- Updated flood plain information will assist local officials in zoning and will assist with flood plain management in the community.
- The technical studies completed under this authority can be used to ensure the accuracy of floodplains.

Consequences

- Without an updated study, communities will not have accurate and current flood plain information.

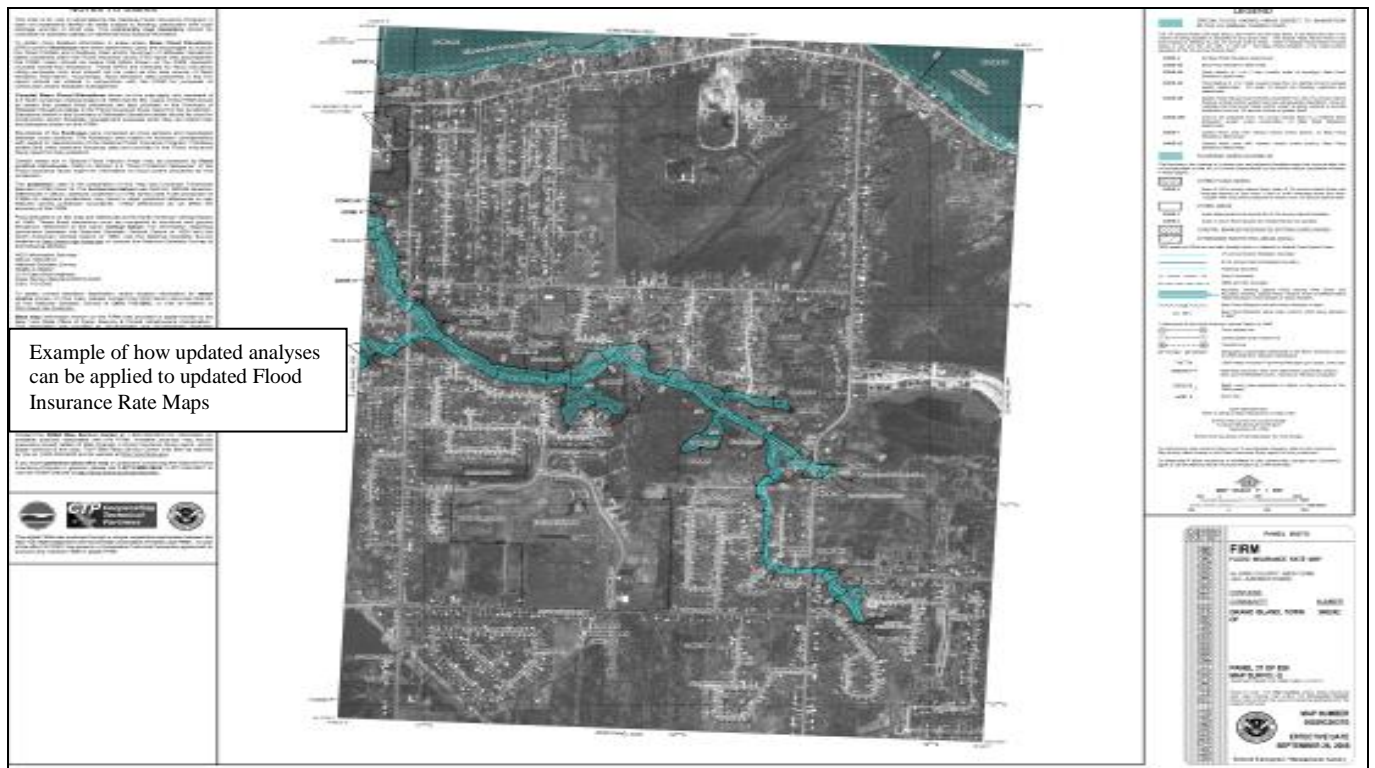
Status

- Detailed study estimates will be provided after coordinating identified study areas.
- Status of ongoing work efforts:
 - Lorain, Ohio, will be completed in FY19.
 - Jefferson County will be completed in FY19.
 - Seneca River in Onondaga County; Hydraulic and; Hydrologic Analyses will be initiated in FY19.
- Coordination is ongoing with resource agencies to identify areas in need of updated mapping.
