Regional Permit Nos. 79-000-3, 81-000-1, 86-000-1, 87-000-1, 87-000-13, 97-000-1, and 99-000-1

AMENDMENT TO REGIONAL PERMITS FOR REQUIREMENTS UNDER THE ENDANGERED SPECIES ACT

The District Commander, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers District, Buffalo, New York, has modified Regional Permit Nos. 79-000-3 for boathouses, 81-000-1 for minor dredging, 86-000-1 for timber crib docks, 87-000-1 for open pile or floating docks, 87-000-13 for fill existing boat slips, 97-000-1 for minor channel work, and Emergency Regional Permit 99-000-1 in waters of the United States within the State of New York and subject to regulation by the U.S. Army Engineer District, Buffalo. This modification is being taken in accordance with Title 33 of the Code of Federal Regulations Parts 320 thru 330 as published in the November 13, 1986 Federal Register, Volume 51, No. 219. This action does not modify the current expiration dates.

The Corps is modifying Table 1 within these permits, which identifies locations of Federally-listed threatened and endangered species and candidate species that may be affected by the Regional Permits. The table was recently updated to reflect the current listed threatened and endangered species. In addition to modifying the table, the Corps is adding the following language to the table, to ensure the most recent ESA information is used:

*As this table may not be up-to-date and is generally an overestimate of areas with listed species, an applicant should use the USFWS Information for Planning and Consultation (IPAC) website (<https://ecos.fws.gov/ipac>) as the primary resource to determine if there may be listed Threatened or Endangered species.
